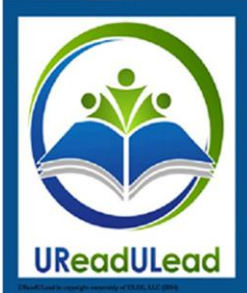

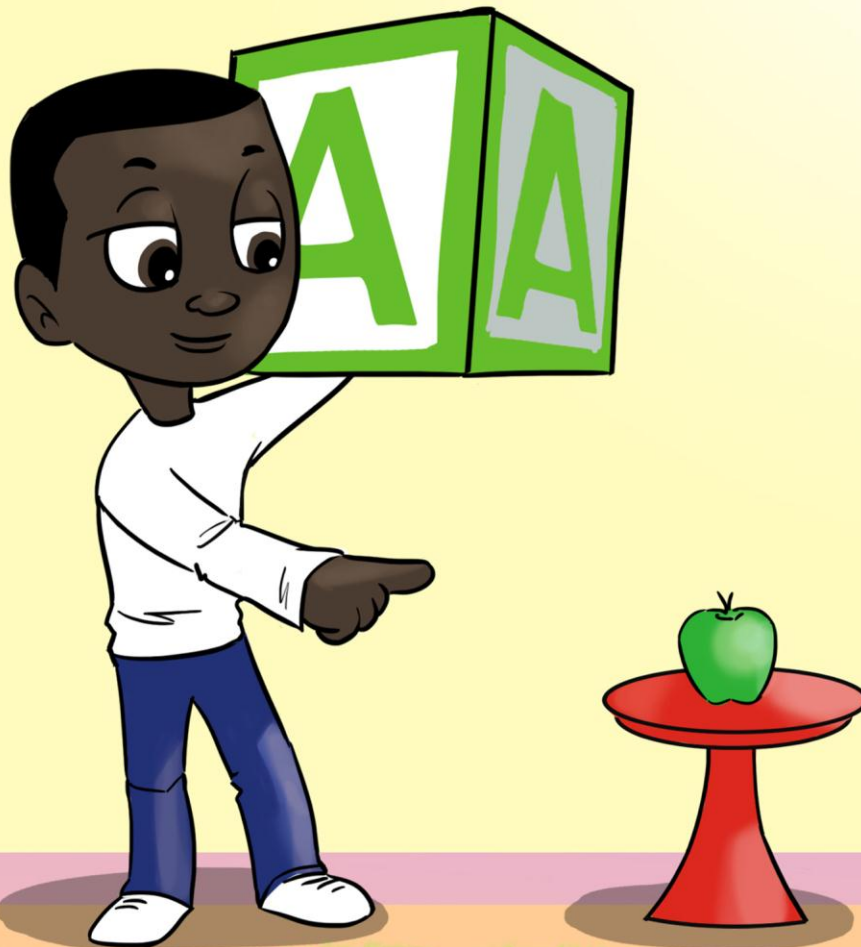
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**Our class was learning the alphabet;

Let’s play a little game.”**




**“You’ll each hold up a letter;
